IMPORTANT TRANSFER NOTES

- x Webster has a minimum residency requirement that 30 of the student's last 36 credits must be taken at Webster University. All students must have a minimum of 12 credit hours to graduate.
- x Transfer students can apply up to 8 credit hours of approved PSYC coursework to the psychology major from another institution. Students may transfer in 3 credit hours of approved foreign language coursework to meet the International language requirement of the B.A. degree.
- x Within each major, a specified number of credits must be upper level.
 - o Psychological Science majors in the B.S. degree must take within the 9 hours of electives, at least 3 credit hours at the 4000 level.
 - o Psychology majors in the B.A. degree must take within the 9 hours of electives, at least 3 credit hours at the 4000 level.
- x Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply toward the major or general education/GCP.
- x Webster University provides full transfer of coursework successfully completed as part of an associate degree awarded by a regionally accredited institution. While students with associate degrees typically transfer 60-64 credits (all) to Webster, we will transfer a maximum of 20 (Senior) or 25 (Junior) credits from the associate degree to Webster.
